INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

My fiance and I were in a car accident on Monday, March 25, 2019 around 915 AM. The man whi hit us, [REDACTED] left scene. I called the police to report it. He returned without his vehicle. While waiting on the police, [REDACTED] kept leaving and returning with out offering his ID and insurance information. During the ordeal he kept leaving and coming back screaming obscenities. My fiance and I decided to just sit in the car while we waited for police to show to have less contact with [REDACTED] While in the car, [REDACTED] walked up to door and so my fiance opened it, he proceeded to tell my fiance he wanted to exchange info. He handed my fiance his drivers licence to hold. He shut the car door to get our insurance card. While he was looking through the papers to find it. He handed me [REDACTED] ID to take a picture of it. When he saw that I was about to take a picture of it, he started screaming and then he opened car door and lunged in untop of us , grabbed me and a squabble ensued to get [REDACTED] out of the car, i dropped my phone, he scratched my hand. We finally got him out of the car. I dropped his license out the window.

A male officer came, [REDACTED] met him first. He spoke with him for 15 minutes then a female officer came and they spoke some more. When they finally came to talk to us they dismissed our claim saying we were not assaulted. And arrested me for his license getting broken. She kept saying everything is being recorded on body cam. You can see video of them barely trying to get an understanding of what we went through.

I tried to file a report against [REDACTED] twice again. Once, I called and tried to do it with 311, but was told to they couldnt override officer on scene. Went to police station on grand to do it. The officer at desk said he said it doesn't work like that and if its not assault what is it, he said he couldnt tell me because hr isn't a lawyer. Then i said what is it when a guy opens your car puts his hands on you then The officer said its , just being an idiot. I asked to speak with sergeant. Officer said, sergeant told him to tell us to google and contact COPA, to make a complaint against the officers for refusing to file complaint. But i want to file a complaint against assailant and officers.
