INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

The complainant [REDACTED] stated that her niece [REDACTED] attacked her physically and with a knife, causing her to flee her home and run to neighbors for assistance. The complainant [REDACTED] alleges that the responding officers would not allow her to sign a complaint against the subject due to the subject's having Bipolar Disorder. The complainant [REDACTED] alleges that she informed the officers that the subject attempted suicide with a knife and the officers did not arrest her or take the subject to the hospital for a psych hold as requested by complainant [REDACTED]. The complainant [REDACTED] stated her niece damaged glass on her entry door and multiple items in the home. The complainant [REDACTED] alleges that the responding officers refused to give her a police report and did not advise her on services for victims of domestic violence. The complainant [REDACTED] stated her niece lived with her and was currently on house arrest. The complainant [REDACTED] also stated that the police saw the blood throughout on the walls and floors throughout her home and on the property outside her home.
