INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

On April, 17th, 2019, I walked into the 63rd Loomis police station, to report a repeat stalker. I told Miss Stanford, badge 64422, that the person that stalked and harassed me for eight years, in a previous state, was stalking me back here, in my hometown, Chicago, where they stalked me, while living in that state. Miss Stanford, appeared disoriented, as if she was waking up. She acted as if she did not believe what I was telling her, when I mentioned that this stalker followed me, from state to state. In the previous state, the stalker broke into places where I lived, tampered with my cars, took pictures of me, and stalked me everywhere I lived and worked. After exposing this person on the news, they eventually, went to jail, not once, but twice. But they did not stop stalking me. Miss Stanford, asked me when I last saw the stalker and I told her, after I left my job at 7 pm, April 11, 2019, at, 8█ S. Canal St. I also told her, that the stalker stalked me at my previous security post, on 1█ S. Morgan St., where I worked overnight security. Miss Stanford, was very loud and insensitive, asking me if I was on blood pressure pills, then she said that I reminded her of someone at a hospital, as if I was some nut case off the street. I was very offended by this person that wears a uniform that says, to serve and protect. I felt that Miss Stanford, was trying to get laughs at my expense, when I was desperately looking for help against some deranged stranger, that is not leaving me alone.
