INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

The reporting party alleges she blew her horn after observing an unmarked police vehicle execute an illegal u-turn. The reporting party alleges the accused officer pulled the reporting party over, requested the reporting party's license and insurance, and refused to tell the reporting party why she was being stopped. An unidentified sergeant arrived on scene and the accused officer and the unidentified sergeant were allegedly verbally aggressive towards the reporting party. The Sergeant said words to the reporting party to the effect of, "I am really close to locking you up." The reporting party was issued a citation for honking her horn.
