INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

Police were called to my house for a civil matter. My ex husband is police officer [REDACTED]. The 3 officers that answered the call told me it was a civil matter yet insisted my children go with their dad. Even though I was told it was civil and I made them aware he was acting irrational they intimidated me until I allowed my children to go. I have a previous complaint with COPA against officer [REDACTED].

COPA Investigator Oscar Nufio called Mrs. [REDACTED], who stated that her and her ex-husband, Officer [REDACTED], have a court order that gives Officer [REDACTED] rights to have their children on Easter day and Mrs. [REDACTED] the right to have the kids on their spring break. Mrs. [REDACTED] stated that this year 2019, Easter and Spring Break for her kids fell in the same week and Officer [REDACTED] wanted to take the kids on Easter day only but she denied him that right. Officer [REDACTED] called the police and the accused responded. Mrs. [REDACTED] alleged that the accused officers told her the situation was a civil matter, but sided with him in that they persuaded her to let the kids go with Officer [REDACTED] for Easter Sunday. The accused officers then left after Officer [REDACTED] left with the children.
