Reporting party alleges that the accused, who was working the 003 District desk, failed to run the license plate of her vehicle when requested by the reporting party to determine if her vehicle had been towed. This resulted in the reporting party believing that her vehicle had been stolen. On May 15, 2019, she received a notification from her insurance company that her vehicle had been towed to a city pound and that she owed approximately \$2100.00 because of the error. The stolen vehicle report was reported under JC219543.
