INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

On June 6, 2019, [REDACTED], a Private Investigator who works for United Detective Agency attempted to deliver a foreclosure summons to Officer Leo Cromwell (Officer Cromwell) the accused. When [REDACTED] rang the doorbell at the Officer Cromwell's home, he spoke with a woman, via a "Ring" doorbell and video camera system. [REDACTED] explained why he was at her home and stated he would return on the next day in hopes that the accused would be present. On June 7, 2019, [REDACTED] returned to Officer Cromwell's home in an attempt to deliver the summons again. When he rang the doorbell, he spoke with Officer Cromwell via the doorbell/video camera system, and explained that he is an investigator assigned to deliver a foreclosure summons. Officer Cromwell responded by saying he was not home and that he was sending the police so [REDACTED] left. A few days later, [REDACTED] family and friends informed him that a photo of him at Officer Cromwell's home was circulating on Facebook with a caption indicating that he is impersonating the police, a claim [REDACTED] alleges was made up by Officer Cromwell.

NARRATIVE SUMMARY:
