Wentworth Ave. Chicago Illinois, the accused PO Adnan SALEH, Star 18236, Employee Number [REDACTED] Unit 002 failed to adhere to Department directives related to processing persons under department control in that it took approximately 5 hours to transport her grandson [REDACTED] to court.
