**Allegation:** It is alleged that on or about 03 July 2019 at 2100 hours and 04 July 2019 at 0600 hours P.O. Jude N. DIMALANTA #17266 failed to return to the radio room in the 016th District at the end of his tour of duty, C.P.D. Motorola Apx 7000, Radio #: D99UA18 with serial number 579CVM2715.
