INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

I was traveling southbound near the 69th block of cottage grove parallel to a CPD unmarked SUV. After making a complete stop at the stop sign, the CPD unmarked SUV got behind me and pulled me over. He said he stopped me for having a headlight out which it was out. While the officer who was on my driver side went back to his car to check my information. Officer number 2 on the passenger side then proceeds to go back and forth with me about why I don't have a city sticker but I don't live in Chicago. I asked officer 2 and 3 to identify themselves and he refused and said it's not his stop or something along them line. When I later asked him again during the conversation he said it would be on the ticket.

Once the officer 1 came back he issued me a ticket for having a headlight out and no Chicago city sticker. I asked officer 1 what's his name and he said it so low and fast I didn't catch it. I took out a pen to write it down and I asked him again and he wouldn't repeat it. I asked him what's his call sign and he wouldn't tell me so I asked him to call for a supervisor. He says my traffic stop is done said if I wanted one I can call for it myself and walks off. I looked at the ticket for his name and it's just a scribble line so I get outta the car to write down their plate number and I asked him again and his partner tells him to drive off and officer 1 drive off. The 3rd officer did not appear to have a tag on or it was obscured.

The traffic stop happened at 69th's cottage grove and the star number listed on the ticket is 9263. Since the district was a few blocks away, I stopped in and spoke to SGT. Benitez of the 3rd district. Not sure on the spelling he took a verbal complaint from me and told me he would call me with a update. Later that night he called me and said he was able to track that officer down and he would be schedule for Sensitivity training. He also informed me that the officers were required to identify themselves when I asked. Two of the 3 officers were wearing body camera and appear to be on. The third officer was mostly by my truck and wasn't able to tell if he had one.
