INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

My car, [REDACTED], a Black Chrysler 200 was parked at 1 [REDACTED] North Paulina, the side street next to the building I live in, 16 [REDACTED] W. Washington Blvd., on Friday, 53119, I parked at this location on Thursday, 530, at 500pm when I returned on 53119, at 1030am [REDACTED] a blue Jeep, 4X4 was on my bumper, I could not backup I moved my car up in order to observe the damage that had been done to my car. Please see pictures that I took at that time of my car and the owner of the car that was on my bumper I had an appointment. I did not write a note and put it on this car until Saturday, 6119, I observed a short Asian man, out of my window take the note off and read it, he got in the jeep and continued to read. I asked him to call me because he had damaged my car. He never called. I made a Police report at 4th District station, on Monday, 6319, the clerk stated they only take a report they do not give out any info on the LP that I provided for other driver. I made a report with my insurance co., that same date, 6419, I sent all photos to my insurance co., Metromile, [REDACTED]. I was told to wait about two weeks for followup from my insurance. When I talked to Metromile again on 62419, they told me to call, [REDACTED] at Esurance Ins. co., the drivers insurance co., at [REDACTED] the claim No. [REDACTED] I called on 625, 712, 715 and 71619 [REDACTED] took my statement and told me her insured denied any accident, he received no note from me, and stated that his damage was from another accident. She left me a voicemail on 71619 stating my photos do not support my claim their insured will not accept liability and that I should reach out to my own insurance co. my insurance told me they will pursue this only if I accept payment and have my car repaired. I do not want to have car repaired until I have pursued all resources as to what happened causing the damage to my car, I want the damage to be seen by all. I am sending this email because the vehicle that damaged my car, has a fraternal order of Police sticker in the window and had a Police band, bluewhite on the rear view mirror inside of the car, see the picture that I had taken since this incident I was sitting in my car on the same side of the street, a Asian man came out and went to the aforementioned vehicle on the opposite side of the street, he was wearing the Police uniform, shirt and pants, no hat and peered through the car window glass of his vehicle to look at me, he turned around and looked at me and left the vehicle. It is my belief that he lives in the 16 [REDACTED] West Warren Blvd., block, we share the same alley, he can observe me from his back porch. We have had no contact or conversation this was a form of intimidation and he has lied to his insurance company as to what happened. It is my belief that he comes home and there is no parks, he saw space behind my car, it was not large enough for his car to fit without being in the alley he attempted to or he did move my car up in order to park his car his car is parked off alley, making a blindspot from any car coming out of the alley. I feel this is all bad conduct and no regard for other peoples property he thought he could damage my car and I would say or do nothing because he has Fraternal order of Police on his window and a Police band in his car. On 61019 I observed a service ticket from a car dealer inside his car, his LP frame had been repaired and the Police band on the rearview mirror was removed from his car.
