1 - Sustained - Operation/Personnel Violations/Weapon/Lost/Stolen Weapon

Allegation:

It is reported by Sergeant David DEL PILAR #1616 that on 03 August 2019, while at the location of 31 [REDACTED] W. Harrison St., Chicago, IL, the Accused Police Officer Sharon R. GODBOLD #17742, Employee No. [REDACTED] failed to properly secure her duty weapon, Smith and Wesson, Model 193, revolver, Serial No. [REDACTED] as is required per Department Directive U04-02, entitled "Department Approved Weapons and Ammunition". On the above date and time the accused left her prescribed duty weapon in the woman's Police locker room unattended.

Rule Violation:

6 - DISOBEDIENCE OF AN ORDER/DIRECTIVE, WHETHER WRITTEN OR ORAL - SUSTAINED – Violation of Rule No. 6: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral in that, Sharon GODBOLD #17742, Employee No. [REDACTED], failed to comply with the provisions of Department Order – Department Approved Weapons and Ammunition: U04-02, in that it has been determined that on 03 October 2019, while at the location of 31 [REDACTED] W. Harrison St., Chicago, IL, the accused failed to properly secure her duty weapon a Smith and Wesson revolver, Model 193, Serial No. [REDACTED], resulting in the firearm being lost. [1 count(s)]

2 - Sustained - Operation/Personnel Violations/Neglect of Duty

Allegation:

It is reported by Sergeant David DEL PILAR #1616 that on 03 August 2019, while at the location of 31 [REDACTED] W. Harrison St., Chicago, IL, the Accused Police Officer Sharon R. GODBOLD #17742, Employee No. [REDACTED], was inattentive to duty by leaving her prescribed duty weapon in the woman's Police locker room unattended. The weapon was a Smith and Wesson, Model 193, revolver, Serial No. [REDACTED]



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Rule Violation:

10 - INATTENTION TO DUTY - SUSTAINED – Violation of Rule 10: Inattention to duty in that, Sharon GODBOLD #17742, Employee No. [REDACTED] was inattentive to duty in that it has been determined that on 03 October 2019, while at the location of 31 [REDACTED] W. Harrison St., Chicago, IL, the accused failed to properly secure her duty weapon a Smith and Wesson revolver, Model 193, Serial No. [REDACTED] resulting in the firearm being lost. [1 count(s)]
