This ASR provides crucial information to reporting parties, accused members and accused members' supervisors. INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

:The RS stated that she was a part time employee of the CPS and was participating in a program at the CPD 311 center. The RS stated that when she arrived at the 311 Center, she entered through a restricted entrance that was propped open. She stated there was a sign posted on the door indicating either restricted or no access. Later, when leaving, she again attempted to access the same door and was confronted by a female employee who directed her to another exit. At this point, the accused intervened in the conversation and identified himself as a Sergeant while lifting his shirt to show a yellow badge on his belt. At this time, the RS was able to see what she believed to be part of a firearm holstered on the opposite side of the waist area. The RS was specifically asked if the accused motioned or reached for the firearm or made any reference to it- and she answered "no". The RS stated the sergeant yelled at her for attempting to enter the area and informed her that it was not the correct exit. The RS states the accused yelled at her and asked her "what she was on", which she believed to be a reference to her using drugs, and explained she was using the wrong door. The RS was specifically asked what her complaint was, at which time she stated- the accused's tone and words which frightened her, along with his unprofessional conduct. The RS was specifically asked if anyone had touched her or if she sustained any injuries- to which she replied "no".
