This ASR provides crucial information to reporting parties, accused members and accused members' supervisors. The information contained herein is intended to display Department member's accountability and foster the relationship with members of the public by ensuring legitimacy and community confidence. The following are definitions of recommended findings:

INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

The Reporting Party made multiple calls via the 911 dispatcher for shots fired into her home, but the 11th District failed to respond to any of those calls. The R/P also related that this occurred after she had [REDACTED] arrested for making threats against her. The R/P believed that the 11th District is retaliating against her by not responding to her calls for service because an Officer by the name of Munoz instructed not to use the word "Gun" next time because [REDACTED] (offender) did not have weapon at the time of his arrest. Shortly after officers left, the R/P made several calls to 911 because someone broke her car window and she believed it to be Offender [REDACTED]'s sister [REDACTED]. While [REDACTED] was actively making threats against the R/P, the R/P called 911 and again 011th District failed to respond to her home. R/P called the 011th District Desk and requested to speak with a supervisor to have a car sent to her home to report the threats she was receiving from [REDACTED]. The R/P was not able to speak with a supervisor.

NARRATIVE SUMMARY:
