Allegations

1 - Sustained - Operation/Personnel Violations

Allegation: It is alleged by Complainant by Sergeant Tanyshia that the Accused Probationary Police Officer Giovanni CHACON does not reside at 8█ N. Richmond Chicago, Illinois 60622 and provided an address of 8█ N. Ridgmont Court, Gurnee, Illinois for a Battery incident recorded under RD#JC418837.

Rule Violation: 25 - FAILURE TO RESIDE WITHIN CORP. BOUNDARIES OF CITY OF CHICAGO - Failure to actually reside within the corporate boundaries of the City of Chicago, in that Probationary Police Officer Giovanni CHACON actually resided at 16█ S. 49th Avenue, Cicero, Illinois 60804. [1 count(s)]

2 - Sustained - Domestic Incidents

Allegation: It is alleged by Police Officer Marvin RANDOLPH that Probationary Police Officer Giovanni CHACON was arrested for Domestic Battery on 26 December 2019 at 16█ S. 49th Avenue Cicero, Illinois 60604 and failed to notify the Department that he was under investigation by another law enforcement agency.

Rule Violation: 1 - VIOLATION OF ANY LAW OR ORDINANCE. - Violation of any law or ordinance, in that Probationary Police Officer Giovanni CHACON was arrested for Domestic Battery 720 ILCS 5.0/12-3.2-A-1 at 16█ S. 49th Avenue, Cicero, Illinois 60804 on 26 December 2019 in that he struck █ twice with a closed fist causing swelling and bruising to her face. [1 count(s)]

Rule Violation: 6 - DISOBEDIENCE OF AN ORDER/DIRECTIVE, WHETHER WRITTEN OR ORAL - Disobedience of an order or directive, weather written or oral in that Probationary Police Officer Giovanni CHACON failed to notify the department that he was under investigation by another law enforcement agency in violation of Special order 08-01-02, section IV and the Basic Recruit Procedural Manual and Regulations Section 1-4, Serious Incident Report. [1 count(s)]

Rule Violation: 20 - FAILURE TO SUBMIT REPORT, MEMBER UNDER INVESTIGATION - Failure to submit immediately a written report that any member, including self, is under investigation by any law enforcement agency other than the Chicago Police Department in that the accused, Probationary Police Officer Giovanni CHACON failed to notify the department immediately in writing that he was under investigation by the Cicero Police Department under case report number 2019-00100861.
