INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

The Reporting Party alleges that the accused officer issued him a traffic citation for which he denies in that he stated that it is lawful for him to display one license plate on the rear of his commercial vehicle. The Reporting Party alleges that the accused officer issued him a citation for being without two license plates. The Reporting Party stated that he went to the 003RD Police Station to ask for assistance, he was told to go to the 006TH Police Station where the accused officer is assigned and when he left the 006TH Police Station, he discovered that he had been issued a second citation for being without a COC windshield sticker, by the accused officer.

Allegation: It is alleged that on 27 September 2019, at 0005 hours, at 5 E. 79th Street, the accused member was unprofessional and rude towards that complainant during a traffic stop.

2 - Exonerated - Traffic (Not Bribery/Excessive Force)/Improper

Allegation: It is alleged that on 27 September 2019, at 0005 hours, at 5 E. 79th Street, the accused member improperly issued the complainant a citation for not having a rear license plate on his work vehicle that is registered as an Apportion Vehicle through the state of Illinois, which only requires and issues one license plate for the front of his vehicle.
