### INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

The complainant alleges that the accused harassed him because the accused told the complainant that he looked under the influence and that his eyes were bloodshot, which the complainant denies. The accused arrived to the scene during a traffic stop that the complainant was involved in and was dismissed from with a warning. The complainant alleges that when the accused was given his warning by another officer that the accused stated "were going to pull him over when he leaves here anyway." The complainant alleges that the accused then followed him and exited his vehicle at an intersection and placed a citation for not having a city sticker on his window.
