INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

On September 23, 2017, Mr. [REDACTED] was stabbed by [REDACTED] his child's grandmother. On September 27, 2017, Mr. [REDACTED] sought and was granted an order of protection against Ms. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] his child's mother. The order was in effect for two years. On October 3, 2019, Ms. [REDACTED] and Ms. [REDACTED] saw and began to argue with Mr. [REDACTED]. On October 4, 2019, the police arrived at his apartment with Ms. [REDACTED] with CPD members accusing Mr. [REDACTED] of producing and threatening them with a firearm. Mr. [REDACTED] alleges the accused, [REDACTED] who is the daughter of Ms. [REDACTED] and the sister of Ms. [REDACTED] assisted her family members file a false complaint against him. Additionally, Mr. [REDACTED] alleges the accused has gang ties with the Gangster Disciples and Breeds gangs who are located near the Douglas Park area and the Washtenaw Projects.
