### Allegations

#### 1 - Exonerated - Arrest/Lockup Incidents/Prisoner's Property

**Allegation:** It is alleged by the reporting party that at 12 S. Racine on 19 November 2019 at 0030 hrs. after he was arrested for domestic battery and his black "Jordan" backpack containing his personal effects including a library card, bank card, a hat, toilet paper, court documents, a pair of pants, a black shirt and a black belt were missing from his vehicle. The reporting party discovered the items missing from his vehicle Wednesday November 20th 2019. Reporting party observed another Police Officer hand his keys to Police Officer Matos who drove off in her squad car and returned a short time later. Officer Matos returned the key to another Police Officer on the scene. Reporting party believes that may have been a mistake and would like his property back.
