



Administrative Summary Report

INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

On November 20th at about 12:55pm I asked the police officer on the scene 71███ S South Chicago to allow me to file a police report against a minor(16/17) that did physical damage to my child inside of the school(Gary Comer College Prep) officer Taylor told me no he would not file the report and no I could not press charges. He said the policy is to allow the school to deal with the matter and discipline the kids as seen fit by the Dean. He spoke with the principle and said her story is different than yours your child started the fight and just lost she didn't come out on top. I explained that the story of the child involved and the teacher inside the class was only half of the story so it's not completely true and that my child was provoked and threatened by the kids prior to my child throwing the first punch and the kids were bullying her before this and came to her job looking for her. I told him I wanted to file a report on the kid that jumped my child in the fight. He then said no that's not what the principle said. She said it was a 4 person fight a 2 on 2 fight. (Which is partly true as to how the fight ended.) But the child number three that did the damage to mine entered the one on one fight, so I want to file a police report against the 3 child that came into the fight which caused the harm done to my child. Needless to say Officer Taylor refused to write me a report and said no several times stating it doesn't work like that siding with the Dean of the school. I called the police station and was informed that yes I could file a report so I had to leave the area and go into another station to make a report. Then after a few days I got a call from a detective and he directed me to the process of moving forward with this report. I took the report and went to the school on December 3rd at about 10:05am once I had confirmed that the child was in attendance. Once police arrived (officer Warren/Stanley) I explained I wanted the person under the police report number to be processed and arrested and gave her the report. She told me I had to go to 111th to obtain a warrant for the child arrest that she didn't know why the detective didn't tell me cause the school don't have to release the child to her. I informed her that wasn't possible because you can't get a warrant for a minor. Then she claimed that she couldn't arrest the child age 16/17 because I didn't have the last name. I told her the child is in the same class as my child and I could get the last name in a matter of 2 minutes. And my child s standing right next to me to which can identify the child. Then the officer said well no I'll call my supervisor to explain to you the same thing or you can just call victim of violent crimes unit and deal with them. Then the white shirt officer arrived(Leighton) and told me to go get a warrant. Once I expressed to him I couldn't obtain one on a minor he said I'll be back and went to his police SUV. Upon returning he came to me with a nasty attitude and said well no warrant no warrant then, call the detective over the case report number and tell him to come deal with it and make the arrest or if you so adamant about getting this kid arrested call the number for violent crimes on this report number cause I'm not about to go get a kid out of school and make a arrest bye have a nice day, and he walked away. All of these officers are out of the station on 7040 S. Cottage Grove and within the two encounters with them they have refused me, lied to me, refused to even try to process/arrest and brushed me off not doing anything to assist me with this matter but take sides with the Dean of the school only going with that side of the story instead of doing their job and allowing the court/judge to make a decision on the matter once processed. I want to file a complaint on all three officers Taylor, Warren-Stanley and white shirt Leighton. I would greatly appreciate if this can be done and I be contacted. Thank you for your time
