INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

Complainant stated that he was involved in a car accident. Complainant stated he was going North bound on Yates Blvd and the other civilian involved, was going West bound on 78th Street. Complainant alleges the accused officer did not complete the report correctly. Complainant stated the accused officer put him at fault. Complainant stated that it was not his fault and the other civilian was not paying attention to the road. Complainant believes that the accused officer was working in the other civilian's favor due to his race. Complainant stated the accused began speaking Spanish to the other civilian. Allegations

1 - Not Sustained - Traffic (Not Bribery/Excessive Force)/Improper

Allegation: It is alleged by [REDACTED] that on 03 December 2018 at the location of 78th S. Yates at 15:00 hours, the accused officer did not complete an accident report correctly putting him at fault and did not issue a citation to the other driver for not having insurance. The reporting party related that he was not at fault, the other driver was not paying attention and the other driver was heading Westbound on 78th St. The reporting party believes that the accused officer was working in the other driver's favor due to his race and the accused spoke Spanish to the other driver.
