INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

I reported my car stolen on the 23rd of February. I told the officer making my claim that I did not want to have my car towed i would come and pick it up. I happened to look at the chicago website to check if the car had been towed and I saw that the car was towed on the 28th. Today is now the third of March and my car was been inquiring fees for 5 days since NO ONE NOTIFIED ME THAT MY CAR WAS recovered. I did not receive any calls or voicemails notifying me that my car was ready to be picked up and if i had not checked the website for myself, I still would be unaware that my car was recovered. And now I AM responsible for the fee that the vehicle was acquired while in the pound. I called the tenth district that recovered the car and was told by the female officer that answered the phone that "she didn't know what to tell me" and "there's nothing we can do about it." She said maybe the officer dialed the wrong number. How is it that Now I am fault because the officer dialed the wrong number even though it was clearly LISTED ON the police report. No one even left a voice message so I could get the car days ago instead of now having to pay over \$300 in fees. That's not fair and I will get my lawyer involved in need be because I have pulled up my phone records and voicemail history from the phone company and have no calls or voicemails notifying me that the car had been recovered. How am I AT FAULT BECAUSE THE OFFICER MADE THE MISTAKE OF DIALING THE WRONG NUMBER??? I SHOULD NOT BE AT FAULT BECAUSE OF THEIR MISTAKE.
