Then I found a policewoman Bradford who would not help me at all. No one would accept a report from me. This is dereliction of duty. I was denied both medical care and police help. No one would take my statement or help me. This is ridiculous. I will report Policewoman Bradford to the Mayor as soon as I get my phone back. This is ridiculous that you let minorities take control of this city without any police protection. YOU ARE ALL FRAUDS!
