INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

Civilian Complaint (George Floyd Protest): On Thursday June 4th, my roommates and I attended the protest that traversed past the police academy. We were appalled by the amount of cops not wearing masks during a pandemic (every protester was wearing a mask) AND the amount of cops whose badges were covered/who were not wearing badges at all. Supervisor after supervisor passed by to organize the unnecessary amount of people/force that was present for a peaceful protest and not one stopped to tell an officer to uncover or put on a badge. No cops told their coworkers to uncover their badges, even after cries from the protesters to remove them. I have photo documentation of a few incidents, but frankly, the entire squad that was present should be held accountable. The mayor said that action would be taken on this issue and I have yet to hear about what is being done.
