



## Administrative Summary Report

This ASR provides crucial information to reporting parties, accused members and accused members' supervisors. ### INCIDENT DESCRIPTION

In short, I am filing a complaint against officer #16981 for refusing to file my police reports, stating it would take too much time of hers to process.

I own and operate Frederick Lynn Haberdasshere located at [REDACTED] E Huron St and have been at this address since 2013. My store has been the target during recent BLM protests and I have been broken into and stolen from on May 30th and August 10th. There was also an attempted break in on March 14th of this year.

The process of filing a police report has been extremely challenging. I've called 311 over 100 times and no answer. I've filed online, but that didn't work because of my report and was directed to another phone number to call and process the report. Once I called that number and explained what had happened the police officer (I didn't get their name or badge number) ended up hanging up on me intentionally. I contacted my Alderman and explained the situation and they provided another number to contact the police which I did and spoke with a very nice policewoman and she said I would need to visit the precinct in person to file these 3 reports.

On Wednesday morning this week at around 8:00 I went into the precinct at 11 [REDACTED] N Larrabee St and was met by 3 officers at the desk. There was nobody else there during my 10 minute visit other than the 3 officers and myself.

Officer #16981 asked what I needed and I explained I needed to file a report for burglary, which is what I was told I had to file this as from a prior phone call I had with an officer, the one who ended up hanging up on me. #16981 was instantly in a bad mood and criticized me for how long it's taken me to file the report from the August 10th protest/riots by BLM. Further, the officer said I wasn't supposed to file the report in the precinct and that I needed to do it over the phone. I explained that I tried to file online and over the phone but was unsuccessful and was advised by the last police officer I needed to go into the precinct to file.

I then mentioned I have 3 reports to file on 3/14, 5/30 and 8/10. #16981 immediately said, "I am not filing 3 reports, do you know how long that will take?!" #16981 said she would only file 1 report, in disgust, and questioned the validity of what I was saying was even true. The way I was treated was appalling and I was made to feel I was wasting her time and she didn't believe my story.

#16981 jokingly asked if I had video proof of all this. She was very surprised when I told her yes, and asked if she wanted to see the 100 thugs break into my store. I explained I had 2 reporters calling me the prior day asking if I will be reopening and the break-ins on my store were all over social media and there were several eye witnesses, other than the criminals who were allowed to loot. I told #16981 I have over 1M in total losses and my small business has been crippled to the point I may not be able to reopen give the lack of safety in Chicago. My business has been wiped out with over 1M in losses and my insurance isn't covering everything and #16981 had the audacity and courage to resist helping me.



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Officer #16981 refused to file these reports for me and that is when I asked for her name and badge number as I told her I was going to file an incident report against her for unwilling to help me file the reports. I told her I would be her and notify my Alderman that she was unwilling to help me because it would take too much time. I need some sort of documentation that this incident is filed against officer #16981 so I can let my insurance company know I was unable to file these reports..
