His father [REDACTED] was also a police officer for many years. Michael ignores my attempts to see our son and refuses to allow me to be in our son's life. I have not committed any crimes nor is there any reason for him to withhold our son, yet he gets away with it due to his privileges as a police officer. I let him know it isn't right what he is doing. He ignores me. I try to show support for him. He ignores me. He needs to finally be held accountable, and just don't have the means to do it. Please help.
